Warm Up:

A period of 55 minutes has been allocated for warm up prior to each session. A warm up schedule will be issued to competing clubs after all entries have been processed.

Please note that all times are subject to change. Any changes in times will be communicated to all competing clubs following meet closure.

Promoter's Conditions

1. The Coalville Swimming Club Annual Summer Solstice Meet 2024 will be held under Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules.
2. The Meet will be held on **Sunday 7th July 2024**. The venue will be Coalville and Whitwick Leisure Centre, LE67 3FE.
3. The pool length is 25m, 8 lanes. The pool will be equipped with electronic timing, anti-turbulence lane ropes and backstroke starting ledges. The depth at the shallow (TURN) end is 1m and at the deep (START) end 2m.
4. All starts will be from the start end of the pool. Overhead/side by side starts will be used at the discretion of the promoter.
5. Swimmers who do not hold the Competitive Start Award must start in the water.
6. There shall be no diving in areas of depth below 1.35m
7. This Meet is open to all Category 2/Compete members of Swim England who will be 9 years of age at 7th July 2024.
8. Subject to meeting the entry criteria below, all swimmers may enter the 50m and 100m events. Only those swimmers aged 11 years and over on 7th July 2024 may enter the 200m events.
9. All swimmers wishing to be considered for entry must be **NO FASTER THAN** the Consideration Times set out below. Times are taken from British Rankings which have been achieved from 1st January 2023 onwards. 'No Time' entries will not be accepted. Where no time is available a coach's estimated time will be accepted for consideration and should be made known upon submission of the entry file.

If space allows, we will accept entries from swimmers who fall outside of the consideration times, however they will not be competing for placing medals, they will be swimming for 'Time only'.

For 'Time only' entries, clubs will need to provide the swimmers' name, their Swim England membership number and a list of events that the swimmer wishes to enter, before the entry window closes.
10. Converted 50m entry times will be accepted for consideration.
11. There are two entry categories, Open/Male and Female.
12. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
13. Any swimmer with a known medical or disability exemption that wishes to enter may do so under the same entry conditions set out above. They should make their exemption known to the promoter 7 days prior to the beginning of the Meet. A certificate of exemption should be presented.
14. The fee for all individual entries is £7.50 per event, with entries only being accepted electronically (see point 20 below). Paper entries will not be accepted.
15. The entry submission window for this Meet shall be from Monday 20th May 2024 until Midnight on Friday 14th June 2024.
16. This Meet will operate on a consideration basis.

17. No late entries will be accepted under any circumstance. Poolside entries will not be accepted for this Meet.
18. The individual times used for entry will be final. Later swims will not be considered.
19. For this Meet we will only accept entries via a Sportssystem's electronic entry file. Clubs will be provided with the Meet file.
20. Entry Files should be sent to Jc20042020@outlook.com and cswimmingclub2022@gmail.com
21. A list of accepted and unsuccessful entries will be issued to competing clubs after the entry window has closed.
22. After the closing date a list of accepted entries and an invoice will be issued to competing clubs. Payment details will be included in the invoice. Payment for entries should then be made to Coalville Swimming Club within 5 working days. **Failure to make payment by the date specified in the invoice will invalidate all entries and result in rejection from the Meet.**
23. We will process swimmer's withdrawals up to 72 Hours before the Meet.
24. All withdrawals must be made using the Google Form located here - <https://forms.gle/ueSP2rfG1wGFvECU7>



Withdrawals which are not submitted this way will not be processed.

25. There will be no refunds issued for withdrawals made after the entry window has closed.
26. Withdrawals made due to medical emergencies will be considered for refund. We will not refund for positive COVID-19 tests.
27. Any refund the club makes will be processed up to 4 weeks after the Meet and will be sent to the relevant competing club(s) to organise internally.
28. In the unlikely event that the pool becomes inaccessible or unusable, the event will be rescheduled. No refunds will be offered, however all accepted entries will be invited to swim in the rescheduled Meet.
29. Details of the final list of accepted entries, session timings etc. will be communicated to the competing club's organisers for them to distribute to their swimmers etc. If there are any queries, please contact cswimmingclub2022@gmail.com
30. Heats will be swum with mixed sexes and age groups combined, with swimmers seeded by their entry times.
31. Swimmers should be sent up 5 heats prior to their scheduled race and should report directly to the competition stewards. Announcements will be made to provide extra information with regards to marshalling, as and when needed.

32. All events will be Age Group Heat Declared Winners.
33. The age groups for the results will be 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, 17/over, age on day of the Meet.
34. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 Open/Male and Female swimmers in each age group in each individual event.
35. Live results will be published and details of the link to these will be made available prior to the start of the Meet.
36. Swimmers should wear appropriate footwear when leaving the poolside.
37. Swimmers are advised to take minimal amounts of clothing and personal affects onto poolside. We ask that you only take a small bag onto poolside with the essentials. There is sufficient locker storage in the changing village which require a £1 coin. This is refundable upon reopening the locker. If you are to bring anything too large onto poolside, we or the Centre staff may ask you to remove your items into the lockers. The reason for this is that a build-up of belongings can restrict the ventilation on poolside.
38. Competing clubs will be advised as to whether there will be sufficient space poolside to allow swimmers to use chairs, after the entry window has closed.
39. Food and hot drinks will not be allowed on poolside, under any circumstances.
40. Swimmers, officials and other individuals must not stand on the raised floor in the smaller pool.
41. All clubs with over 7 swimmers entered into the meet are asked to provide at least 2 qualified licensed officials. In addition to licensed officials, we would also be happy to provide mentoring opportunities for trainees where possible.
42. All volunteers, coaches, team managers and chaperones should bring with them their printed Swim England accreditation. If you do not have accreditation please visit the following link, to access and print accreditation https://www.swimmingresults.org/member_options/

If accreditation is not shown upon request, access will be denied and should it need to be printed by the Meet, it will incur a charge of £5 per pass.

The Meet will provide volunteers with a lanyard and wallet for the accreditation, which is to be worn at all times and should be returned at the end of the Meet.
43. Officials should wear their license at all times.
44. No expenses will be paid by Coalville Swimming Club to officials assisting at this Meet.
45. Lunch will be provided for officials working both sessions.
46. Clubs can purchase a food pass for £5 per member, for the coaches, team managers and poolside volunteers.
47. Clubs will be sent a form to complete, declaring which volunteers, coaches and team managers will be on poolside for each session. The form will include an option to order a food pass. Only those volunteers listed on the form and who have the correct accreditation will be allowed access to the poolside.
48. Clubs are required to decide within their individual risk assessments the required number of Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones along with gender of these for their team for each session. 49. Coach/Team Manager/Chaperone poolside passes will be issued in accordance with Swim England guidelines i.e. a minimum of 2 passes per club for up to 10 swimmers and then 1 pass per 10 swimmers thereafter.
50. Swimmers remain the responsibility of their club, parent(s) and guardian(s) at all times during this Meet.
51. Spectator entry will be £5 per session or £8 for the day. Children Under 10yrs and concessioners will be £3 per session or £5 for the day. The door marshals will provide a wristband as proof of payment.
52. We will accept both cash and card payments.
53. Spectator seating at the Leisure Centre is limited and with this in mind, we ask that spectators rotate where possible, so that everyone has the opportunity to witness their own swimmers compete.
54. The Leisure Centre has a free car park. If necessary, an overflow car park is located at Stephenson's College, LE67 3TN.
55. In accordance with Swim England's policy, **NO** mobile phone or similar devices should be used, or out, in the changing area. This applies to all persons at the event. Should this condition be violated, we reserve the right to take disciplinary action, including ejection from the Meet.
56. The Leisure Centre has a no photography and no filming policy, which we support entirely.
57. Centre users are advised not to leave clothing or other articles unattended as neither the Promoter nor the Pool management are able to accept and responsibility for loss or damage.
58. Coalville Swimming Club complies with Swim England's GDPR policy.
59. Any conditions not covered by this document will be at the discretion of the Promoter, Coalville Swimming Club.
